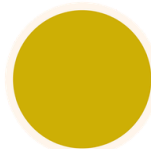

Follow-up and Project Revisions

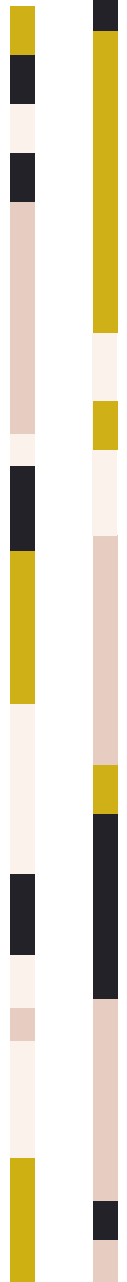

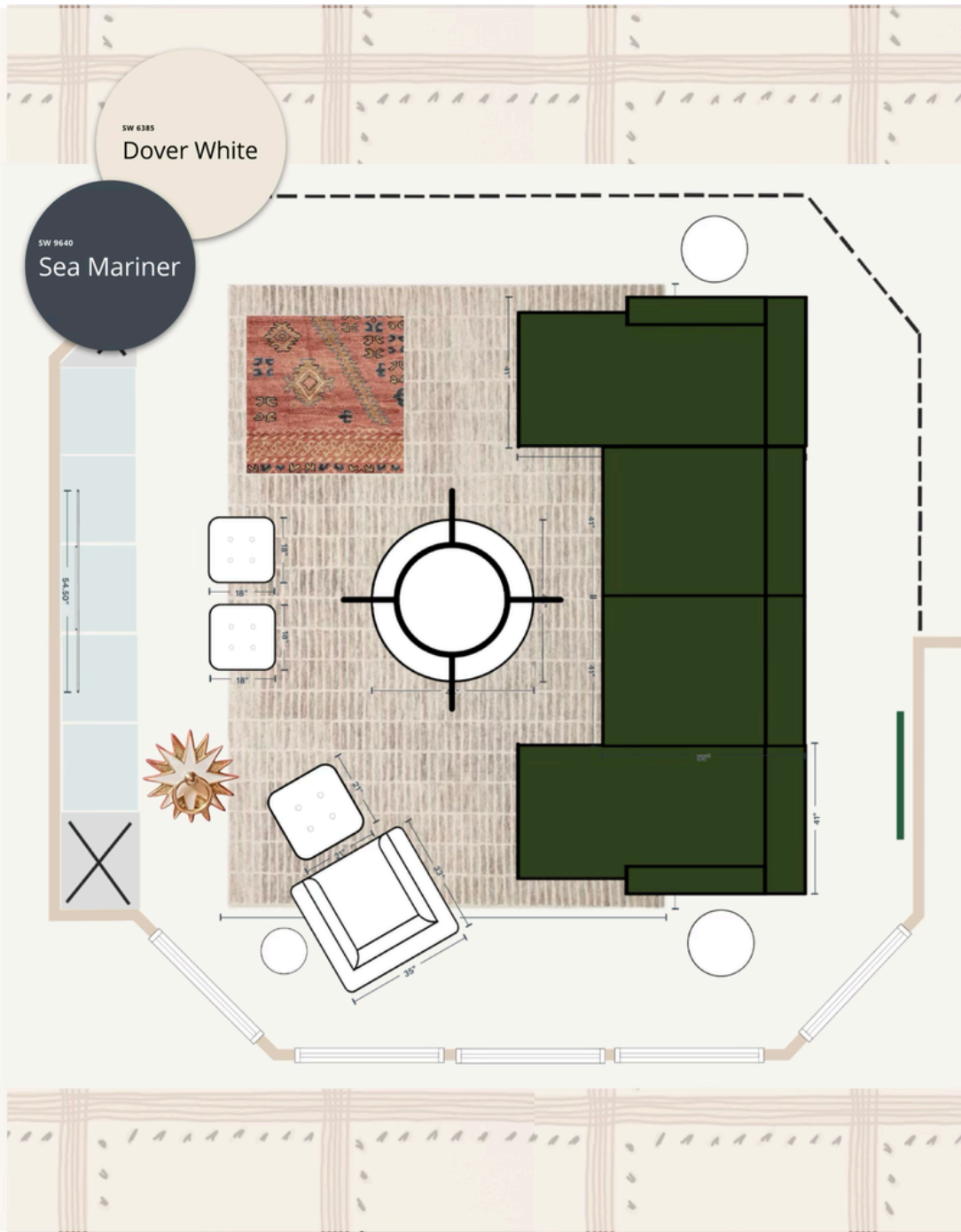
